

FREE TEST PREP SERVICE FOR SALEM RESIDENTS

- ❖ Salem residents who are patrons of the Salem Public Library have free access to the test preparation service **Learning Express Library**.
- ❖ A **Salem Public Library Card** provides online access at home to over 300 online practice exams and quizzes for standardized test preparation (SAT, ACT, GED, U.S. Citizenship, TOEFL, and more). In addition, several basic skills products, both online and in print, are available with Spanish translation.
