

Cameron's commitment to academics combined with his passion for the field makes him a valuable asset to any team or project in the automotive industry.




Salem Rotary Vocational Achievement Award Aiden Burnett






Salem Rotary Directors Award Lisy Almonte Genao

Lisy is a true artist whose talent and craftsmanship are evident in all of her work. Her future goals include art and design in some capacity.




Salem Rotary Vocational Achievement Award Melany Garcia


Corey Grimes


